Anakie Primary School is looking forward to a great year of teaching and learning next year and would like to advise you of Anakie Primary's parent payment arrangements for 2021.

School Council is most appreciative of the high level of support that the school received from parents in 2020, which has not only supported teaching and learning opportunities, but also improving our beautiful building and grounds. We make every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

Section 1: Family Voluntary Donation

Anakie Primary continues to welcome your voluntary contributions to support our school. Our School Council is pleased to continue with a **\$120** per family **General Contribution**, which takes the place of previous "per student" payments. The **General Contribution** is an important payment that is used wholly to purchase items and materials that help support instructional programs at Anakie Primary School. These programs include quality Literacy and Numeracy programming, along with other curriculum areas such as Integrated Inquiry and PE. A major focus in 2021 will be to fund our Reading Support Program and the ongoing beautification of our learning environment.

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Section 2: Student Extra Curricular Activities

Bulk Payment for Extra-Curricular Activities. Each Semester all children are involved in major and minor excursions plus incursions where they have access to visiting groups. These include MVA Events, GPAC Performances, Inquiry Learning outings, etc. The bulk payment for excursions will contribute to a much greater efficiency for staff organising excursions and reduce the pressure on young children being asked for payment before each activity.

Section 3: Student Booklist – Essential Stationery Resources

(A) The Essential Stationery Resources listed below are those used in the classroom during teaching and learning activities throughout the entire school year and used for project

based learning, publishing of student work and specialist areas. **Payment for stationery packs can be made by Direct Deposit, BPAY to your family account or by cash in envelope delivered by your child. Payment of stationery packs is required prior to your child being issued with any of their learning materials.**

(B) Though they require payment, **ALL STUDENT** stationery packs do *NOT* need to be collected, as these will be distributed to students throughout the school year. Students will receive some items on the first day if payment has been made (diaries, reading satchels, writing tools, etc), with a vigilant approach to a sustainable teaching and learning model. We trialled this process in 2019 & 2020 and found that it has reduced costs for 2021 and beyond.

(C) Please note the '**Please supply your own:**' section and have these items available for the first day of the school year. The Department of Education and Training approves payment for teaching and learning programs that engage, support and encourage our students to grow as confident, independent and active learners. Students require the tools to assist them to learn in the form of **Essential Student Stationery Resources**

School Council has carefully considered the setting the cost of financial being requested from parents and has endeavoured to keep the total amount as low as possible, without compromising the level of resourcing being made available to the students.

A payment plan will be available should families wish to choose this option.

The opportunity for parents to pay one instalment in full of or 4 instalments for first child is available. Additional children will need to have the \$80.00 added and divided by the 4 instalments if choosing this option. *At least part payment must be made towards stationery packs prior to stationery being distributed.*

We request that full payment of the 2021 Financial Contributions be made by Friday 5th March 2021 or if you wish to pay by 4 instalments;

the first instalment by Friday 5th February 2021, and second instalment by Friday 9th April 2021, third Instalment by Friday 16th July 2021 and fourth instalment Friday 10th September 2020.

Last item we would like each family to donate a box of tissues to the office and they will be distributed to classes as required.

PARENT PAYMENT INFORMATION for 2021

Healthcare Card and Pension Card Holders can also claim \$80 for Excursions under the Camps, Sports Excursion Fund (CSEF). The total amount of this fund is \$125, which leaves \$45 credit towards the Swimming Program or Camps Program.

To apply for this, forms are available at the Office whereby the form and a copy of Card must be presented at the School office prior to application closure at the end of Term 2.

REGULAR PART PAYMENTS / PRE PAYMENTS

Making regular payments can greatly assist parents with spreading payment costs throughout the year. It may be as small as \$20 per week or a \$50 per fortnight amount. Any spare money can be put on your account at any time. For example, you may wish to make small prepayments for the swimming program from the beginning of the year even though swimming is held at the end of Term 3. Prepayments can be made by:
